The Combustion Institute is currently developing a modern Account Management System (AMS) that will work in conjunction with the new CI website: [CombustionInstitute.org](http://CombustionInstitute.org). The AMS live date is set for **15 January 2017**. Until that time, registered users are unable to access their accounts.

The AMS will use modern web portal technology to maintain detailed user accounts, accept submissions and registrations, and provide a subscription option for the CI newsletter. In the meantime, news and events may be followed on our website and [social media](#) channels.
