Section meetings and workshops since 2016 with date and attendance information:

The 14th International Symposium on Combustion was held on April 25-27th, 2018, in Karabük, Turkey **by Turkish Section of the Combustion Institute**, Karabük University and University of Sakarya. The aim of the symposium is bringing common efforts of the scientific communities in soliciting works and promoting the participation of scientists, engineers and students working on combustion. Participants from all countries of the world are always welcome and submission of papers from groups not located in Turkey was greatly appreciated since it is considered a valuable contribution to enrich different points of view as well as to communicate last achievements in the field. All scientific and technological approaches in the combustion field were accepted to the Symposium.

SHELL sponsored conference: 6th Fuels and Combustion in Engines Conference was held on May 18-21, 2017, in Cappadocia, organised by University of Sakarya and Erciyes University. There were several invited talks, two workshops organized in a cooperation with TUBITAK (Turkish National Research Association) and many papers and posters presented during the conference. The aim of the FCE conferences attracts posters from on-going projects, invited lectures from well known researchers from all over the world and possible project partners from industry to encourage Transfer of Knowledge between Universities and Industry.

A workshop is organised in a cooperation with Cambridge University, CMCL Innovations (UK) and Team-SAN (Turkey) companies in 25 – 26 November 2016, Antalya on “ICE and Modeling Techniques” supported by TUBİTAK.

A workshop called “International Workshop on Smart Strategies For Environmentally Friendly Energy Production and Safety” will be organised in a cooperation with Coventry University and University of The West Of England (UK), Sakarya University (Turkey) and Team-SAN (Turkey) company in 14 – 16 September 2018, held in Antalya supported by TUBİTAK.

Several students who were informed by our section was accepted and attended the summer schools of the Institute and other Sections.

Three researchers attended one week visit to Greece within STSM program of a COST project called SmartCats (CM1404) on Combustion related areas within in 9-13 July 2018.
